












VALEURS PARC NATUREL RÉGIONAL

It was to that end that the regional natural parks jointly created the brand VALEURS PARC NATUREL RÉGIONAL, trademarked by the French State and promoted at both local and national level.

WHAT DOES THE BRAND PROVIDE FOR BENEFICIARIES AND CONSUMERS?

The brand showcases local products and services that comply with specific criteria for consumers who are increasingly aware of sustainable development issues, in keeping with the brand's values.


The beneficiaries (self-employed, companies, cooperatives, etc. corresponding with the values of the brand) are shown to be responsible economic stakeholders, committed to the development of their local area.

They join a regional and national network in a process of continuous improvement. They share their experiences and benefit from the advice and technical support of the Parks' staff and partners.

The beneficiaries can display the brand label on their communication tools: documentation, website, packaging, sales outlets, stands ... and by leans of the brand they are supported by a regional and national promotion campaign for their products and services.
